EMERGENCY CARD INFORMATION

In accordance with Rising Stars Academy Policies, for the protection of our students health and welfare, it is a requirement that parents or legal guardian keep current emergency information at the academy. The emergency information will include: the parent or guardians home address, parents emergency contact phone telephone number(s) and contact phone number(s) of a relative or friend who is authorized to care for the student(s) in any emergency situation if the parent or legal guardian cannot be reached. We would appreciated you taking the time to fill out your child(ren)'s current emergency information for care. Please include at least three (3) different telephone number and names of responsible persons to contact. Please return this information to Rising Stars Academy immediately. We are requessing that you inform Rising Stars Academy whenever this information changes.

ATTENDANCE AND ABSENCE POLICY

Establishing good attendance and punctuality is important. These habits have a lifelong value. Please monitor the time your child goes to bed so that he or she will be well rested and ready to learn. When your child returns to school after an absence of one day or more, as a courtesy send a note explaining the reason and give it to the child's teacher (more than 3 days requires a doctor's note, if prior vacation was not approved).

SCHOOL UNIFORMS AND STUDENT DRESS STANDARDS

This school year we will again require our students to wear school uniforms. Boys uniforms consist of grey pants, white button down shirts, red tie, and blue cardigan sweater with the school logo (shoes may vary).
